“We can’t claim to love our neighbor if we leave him to s\_\_\_\_\_.”

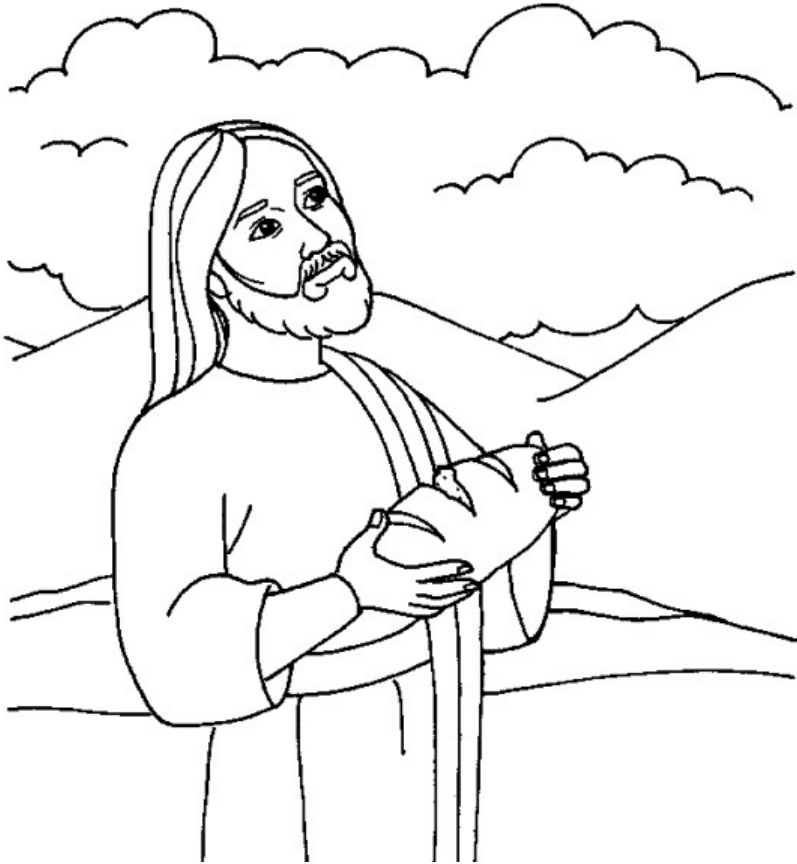
